

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND REGULAR MEETING OF THE
SANTA RITA UNDERGROUND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT
BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

A **PUBLIC HEARING** of the Santa Rita Underground Water Conservation District will convene at 5:00 PM on the 16th day of June 2026, at the District Office, 108 US HWY 67 West, Big Lake, Texas, to receive public input at a hearing on the proposed desired future conditions (DFCs) of groundwater resources located within Irion County and surrounding areas located within Groundwater Management Area 7 (GMA 7). The District's proposed DFC for the next 50 year regional planning cycle are:

Edwards Trinity (Plateau): Average drawdown not to exceed and average of 47 feet in 2080 compared with 2010 levels

Pursuant to Texas Water Code § 36.108(d-2), a 90-day public comment period began on May 5, 2026 which is the date the proposed DFCs were mailed to the GMA 7 districts. Comments may be submitted orally or in writing during the District's hearing or in writing to the District's office, Attention General Manager JJ Weatherby, PO Box 849, Big Lake, Texas, 76932. After this hearing and comment period, the District will compile for consideration at the next joint planning meeting of the GMA 7 districts a summary of relevant comments received, any suggested revisions to the proposed DFCs, and the basis for any revisions.

The **REGULAR** meeting of the Santa Rita Underground Water Conservation District will convene immediately following the PUBLIC HEARING on the 16th day of June 2026, in the District Office, 108 US Hwy 67 West, Big Lake, Texas to transact the following business:

The District's proposed DFCs for the next 50-year regional planning cycle are:

Edwards-Trinity (Plateau): average drawdown not to exceed an average of 47 feet in 2080 compared with 2010 levels


